A256 WHITFIELD BYPASS, WHITFIELD

(30 MPH SPEED LIMIT)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2017

For the safety of the public and workforce during works to construct a new roundabout, Kent County Council has made an Order to impose a temporary mandatory 30 mph Speed Limit on part of A256 Whitfield Bypass, Whitfield, near Dover.



A temporary compulsory 30 mph speed limit will be imposed at all times in both directions on A256 Whitfield Bypass, from a point approximately 200 metres south of the existing pedestrian subway under the Whitfield Bypass (south-west of Pineham), northwards to a point approximately 65 metres north of the subway.

The actual extent of the 30 mph speed limit will be clearly indicated by relevant signs clearly displayed on site.

The 30 mph limit is in conjunction with the existing temporary compulsory 40 mph speed limit, which remains in force either side of this limit, from the junction with A2 Trunk Road northwards to the bridge where Archers Court Road crosses Whitfield Bypass.

The 30 mph limit comes into force from Monday 13 February 2017 and remains in force until works have been completed, currently estimated to be by the end of November 2017.

Due to the nature of these works, it will not be possible to lift the restrictions outside the working hours.
