Proposal: Retrospective application for the change of use to residential institution (Use Class C2)

Location: Hay Farm & land Adjoining, Hay Lane, Eastry

The members considered the additional plans and although they had no objections in principle they were concerned that the use of some of the outbuildings for residential occupancy will constitute an over intensification of a Farm Site situated in a rural location

Proposal: Retrospective application for the erection of decking and fence panel

Location: Turnstone, Gore Lane, Eastry
